# THE PROJECT TERRA

This strategic partnership is based on the development of the learning path in 3 stages "let's create the climate for...change": a unique blend of findings and knowledge from different scientific fields related to climate changes along with the preservation and valorization of cultural heritage, will be offered in such a way to be accessible to everyone. Each partner Organization will then adapt contents and methods to local and/or national contexts, with the aim of sensitizing and encouraging participation in subsequent stages, as well as to the benefit of their operations and impacts on target groups. They will be introduced to the projects contents and practices to let them empower their skills and competences and allow them to raise their readiness to implement innovative educational methods, based on environmental sustainability.

Project activities have been designed to have

the following impacts:

- increased awareness and reinforced Organizations' competences as regards the "transformative learning", as the results of decades of scientific research applied to environmental sustainability, climate changes and circular economy;
- increased capacity to enrich the current services offer, with the introduction of new methods, new contents, such as the Transformative Learning Paths in Stages;
- increased capacity to develop and establish cooperation with like-minded organizations from other Countries of Europe;
- Increased awareness as regards the social and educational value of European cultural heritage, especially in regards to its preservation and valorization.

The **TERRA** project is based on the development of the learning path in 3 stages "let's create the climate for... change":

### Stage 1:

26th November 2019, Ascoli Piceno, Italy: to raise their readiness to implement innovative strategies, to increase their motivation as well as that of prospective adult learners

## Stage 2:

18th-19th January 2021 (Virtual), originally planned in Bruxelles, Belgium to exchange those good practices based on the preservation of cultural heritage as enhancement of environmental, social, cultural and economic sustainability

## Stage 3:

28th July 2021. Stockholm, Sweden, to work on: European Institutions, environmental sustainability and lifelong learning, how to communicate synergies and interactions between environmental sustainability and preservation and valorization of cultural and natural heritage and the disadvantaged groups
